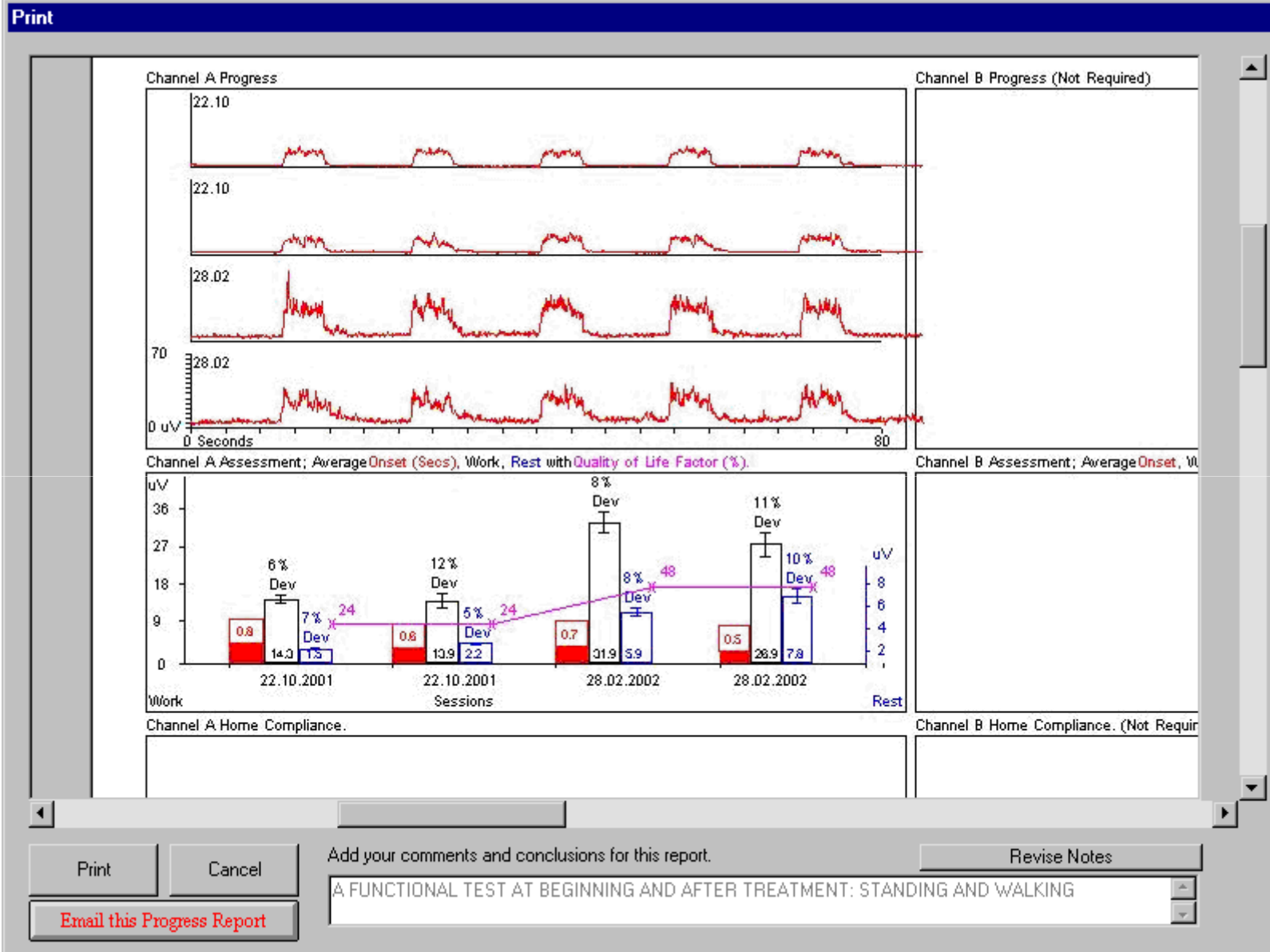


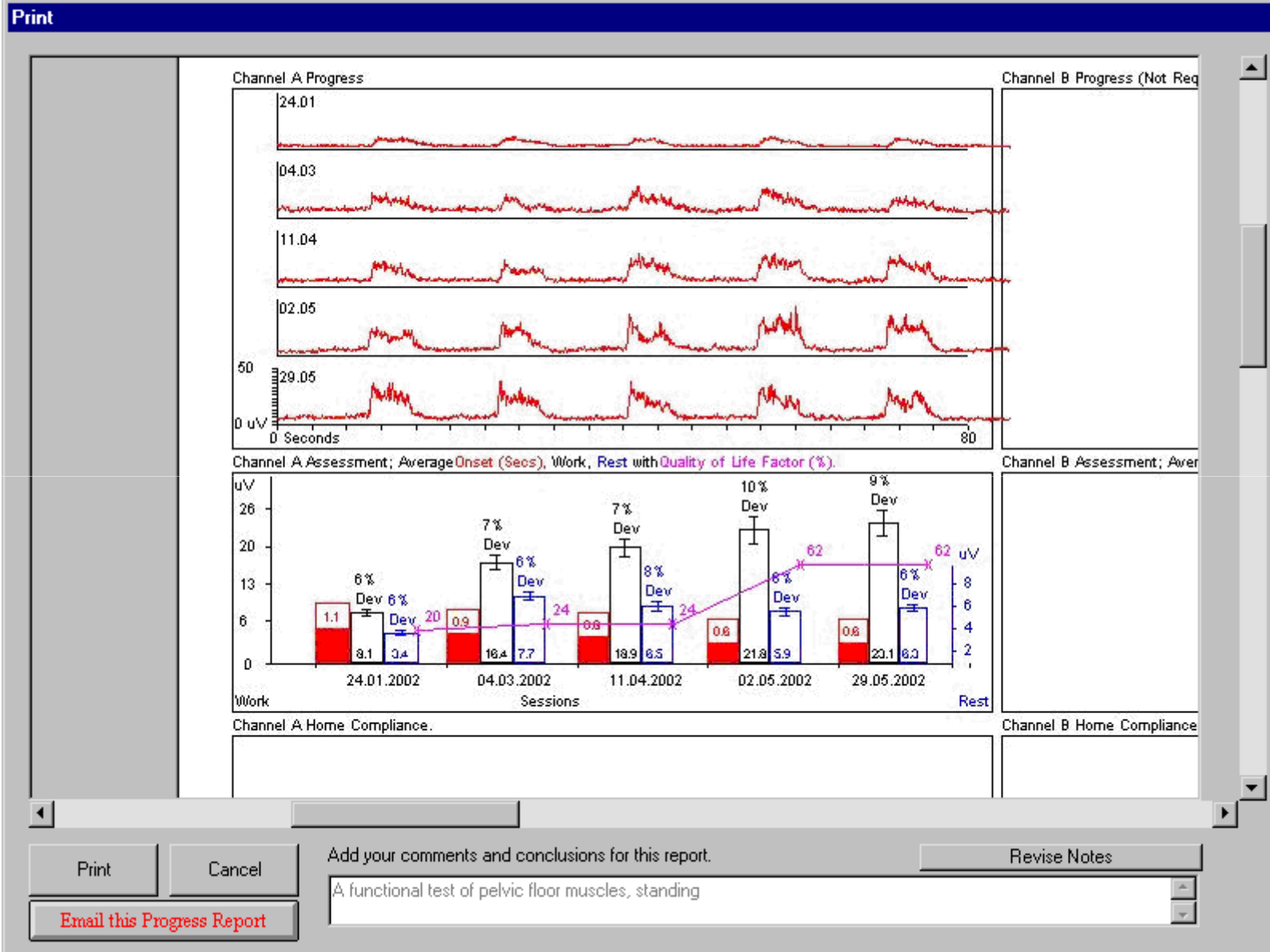
Case reports of therapy with NeuroTrac ETS and NeuroTrac 4

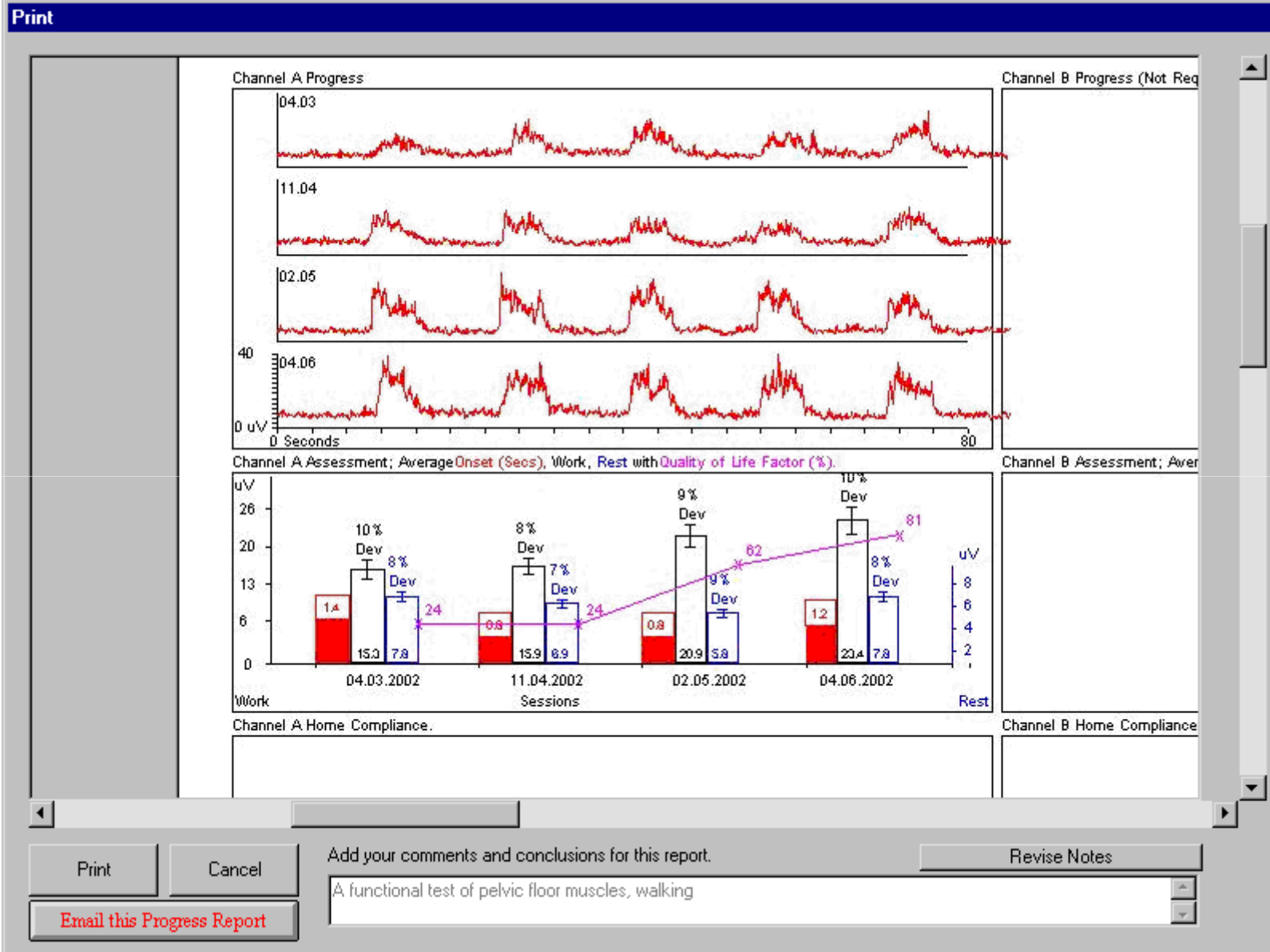
- A woman 34 years
- both faecal and urinary incontinence after traumatic delivery, conservative treatment
- out-patient visits and home training with NeuroTrac4
- intravaginal and -anal probe alternating

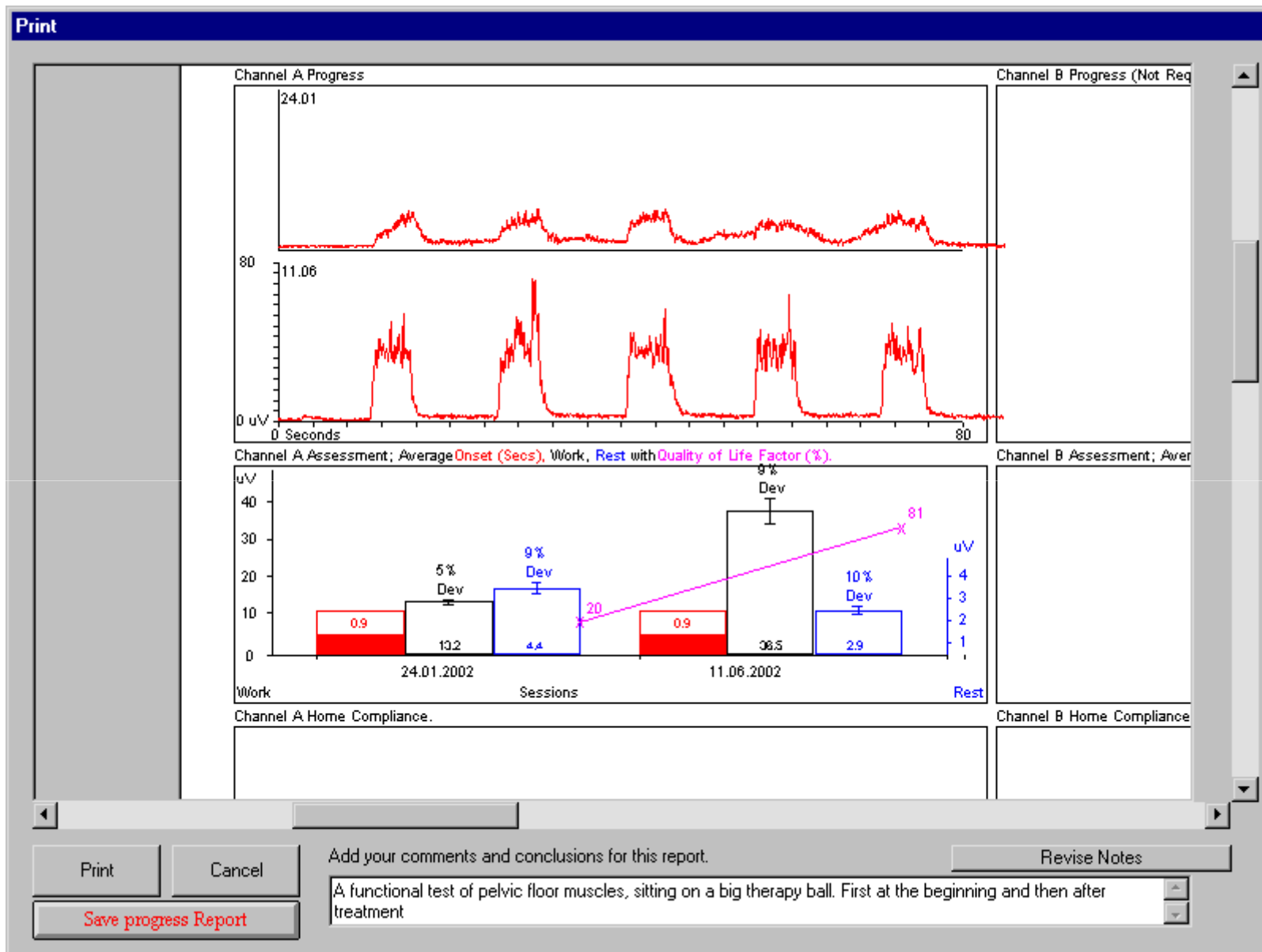


Anal sphincteroplasty and levatorplasty, obstetric trauma

- A woman 77 years, defect of the external sphincter, operation 10/01 after 45 years of delivery
- faecal incontinence after sphinctero-levatorplasty operation
- out-patient treatment weekly, functional, individual home training program





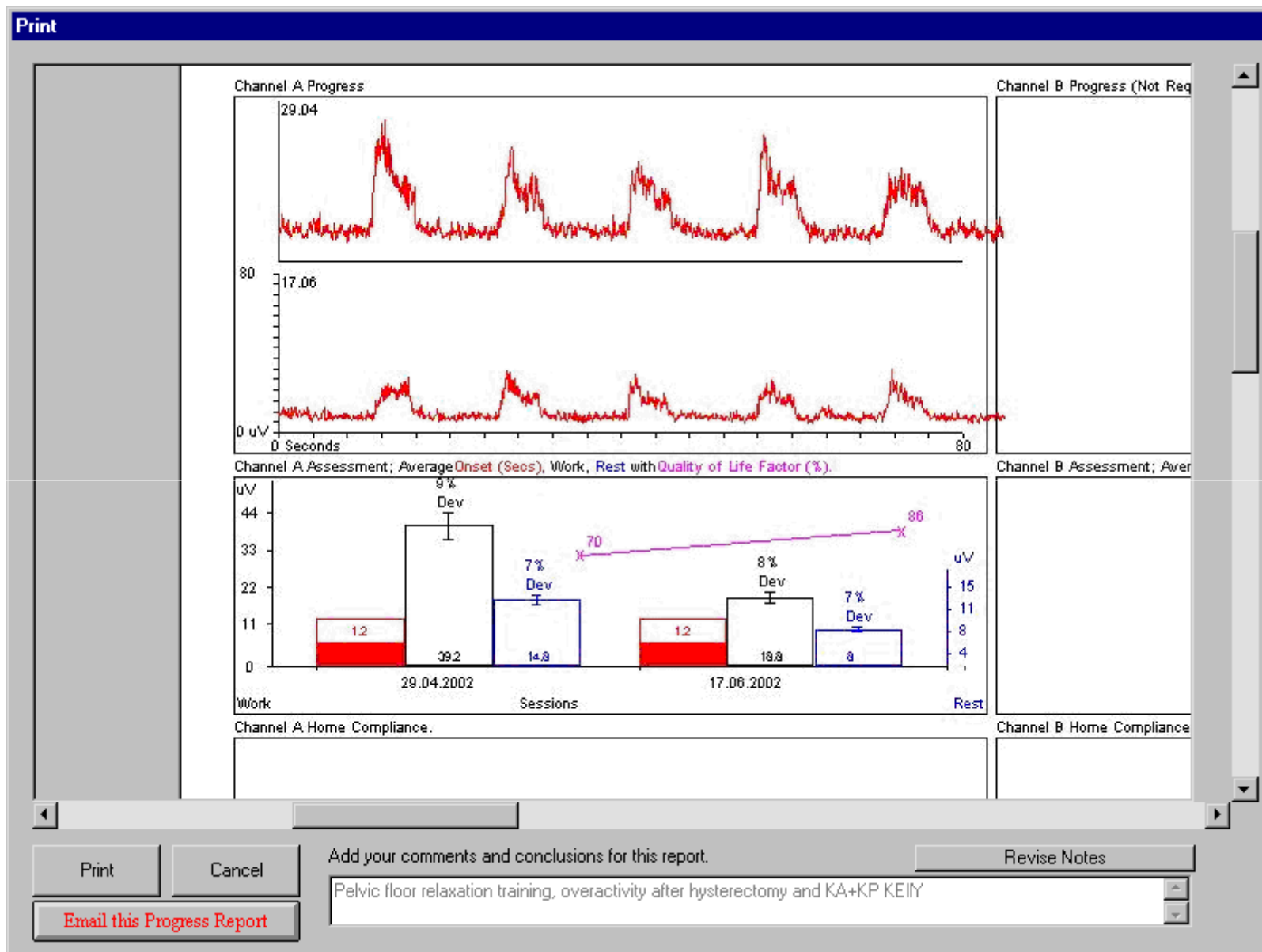


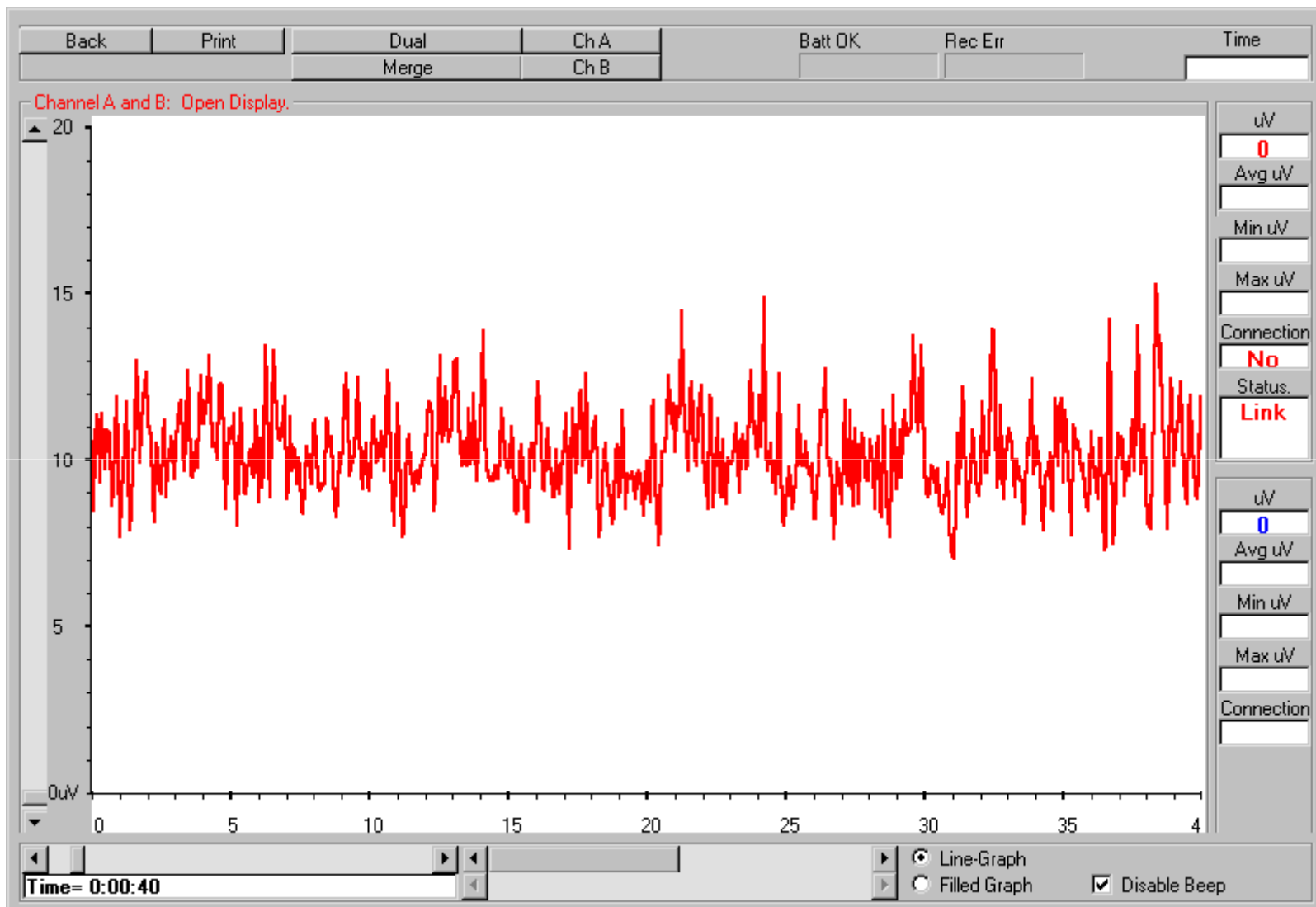
Overactivity of pelvic floor muscles following surgery

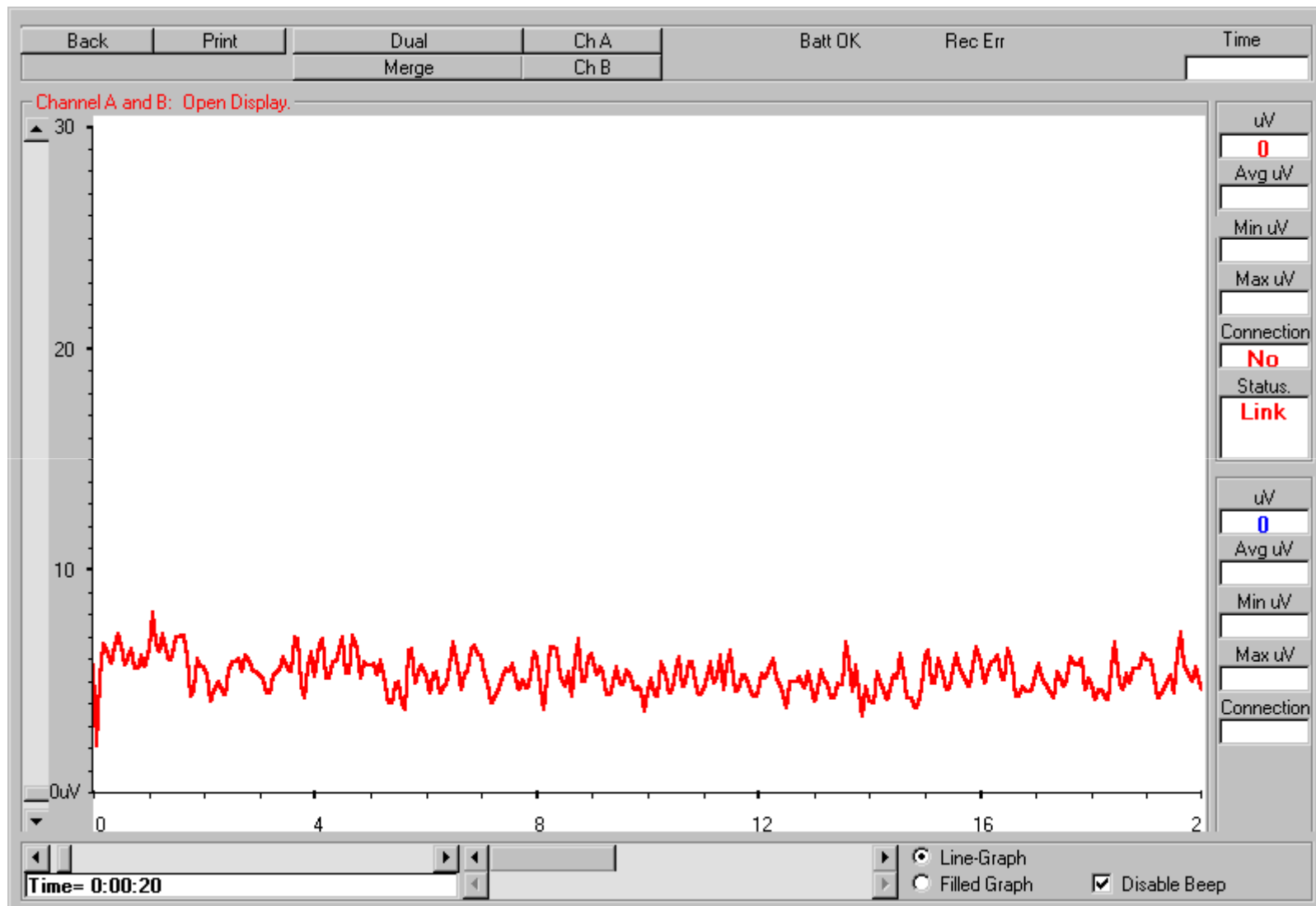
- Women 58 years
- Hysterectomy vaginalis, KA+KP Kelly 02/02
- urinating difficulties afterwards
- no knowledge of overactivity
- exercises with EMG to relax and to urinate too

Overactivity of pelvic floor muscles

- At beginning: resting tone 10,5 microvolts, sitting on a big therapyball
- after training: resting tone 6,2 microvolts
- urination easily







Descending perineum syndrome

- A woman 56 years, delivered
- Constipation, outlet obstruction (defecation difficult)
- stress urinary incontinence
- out-patient visits, weekly, ETS-program important, home training
- symptoms gone after treatment
